RESOLUTION NO. 09-40-20

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REQUEST FOR REIMBURSEMENT FROM
THE IOWA COVID-19 GOVERNMENT RELIEF FUND**

WHEREAS, this resolution by the city of Knoxville to request reimbursement for eligible costs related to the COVID-19 public health emergency from the Iowa COVID-19 Government Relief Fund; and

WHEREAS, the United States Congress approved the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act to provide economic relief related to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Governor Kim Reynolds allocated \$125 million of the State of Iowa's CARES Act funding to local governments for direct expenses incurred in response to the COVID-19 emergency; and

WHEREAS, local government funding reimbursements may only be used for necessary expenditures incurred due to the COVID-19 pandemic, that were not accounted for in the current fiscal year city budget, but were incurred during the time period of March 1, 2020 through December 30, 2020 and have not been reimbursed from other sources; and

WHEREAS, City Council designates the City Clerk as the City's authorized representative to submit reimbursement requests under the Iowa COVID-19 Local Government Relief Fund in accordance with the terms and guidance of the program.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the City of Knoxville requests reimbursement of eligible expenditures in response to the COVID-19 public health emergency; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City of Knoxville affirms that all reimbursements submitted will follow the Federal and State of Iowa guidance on how the funds should be spent, and understand if the funds are misrepresented, the City of Knoxville will be liable for repayment and any applicable penalty and interest.
